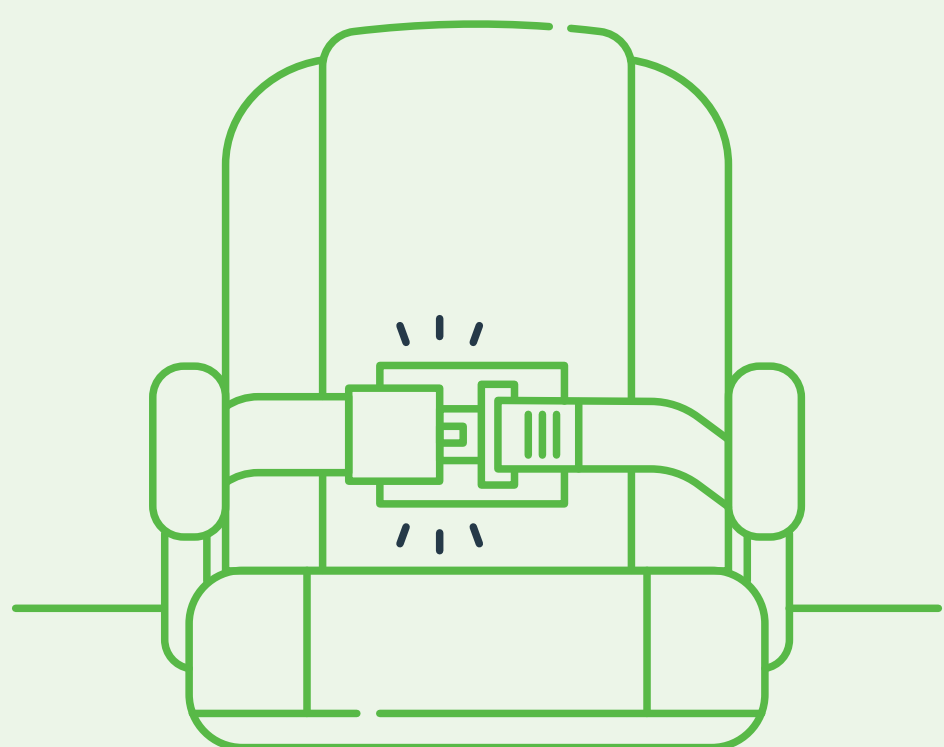

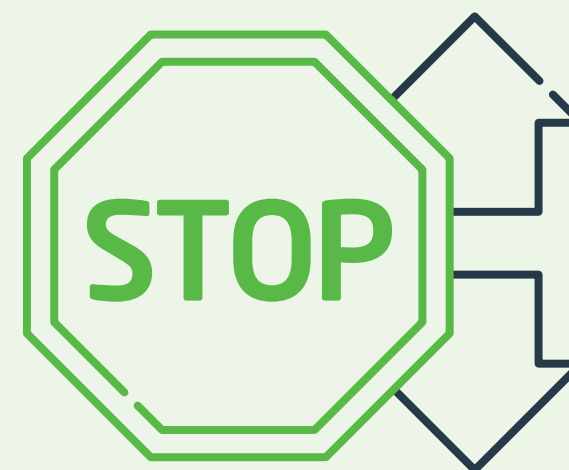


BUCKLE UP

FORKS

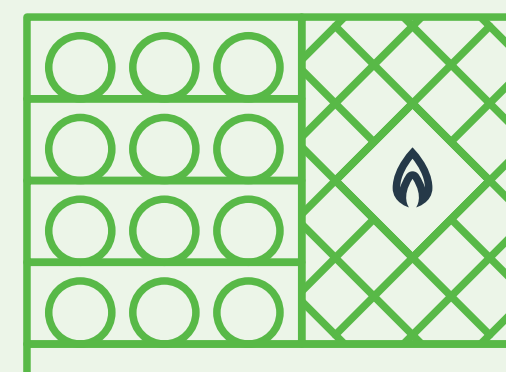
SET PARKING BRAKE

CLOSE SERVICE VALVES

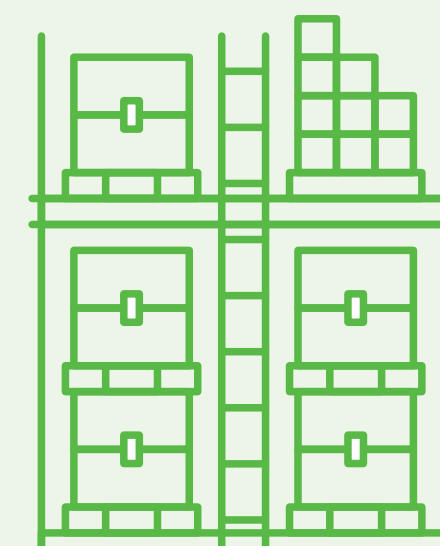
ON PROPANE CYLINDERS

KEEP LOADS

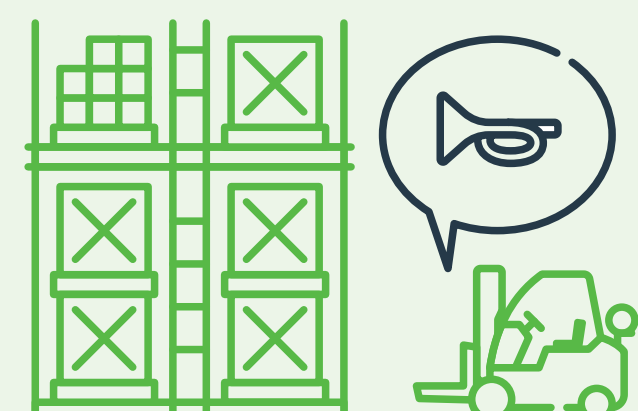
